
## DIY MINNIE EARJ

## ATERIALS NEEDED:

- Black Headband (1 inch wide)
- Black Felt
- Thick Foam Sheet
- Ear Template
- Scissors

- White Pencil
- Hot Glue Gun and Hot Glue
- Pink Ribbon (2 Sizes: 1.5 inch & 1/8 inch)
- Foam Star Stickers
- Ruler IT RUGTION
- Using the Ear Template and White Pencil, trace 2 ear outlines on the felt and 2 smaller circles on the foam. If you bought thinner foam, trace 4 (since you'll need to double up the circles on the ears).
- Cut out the felt and foam ear pieces.
- Assemble Your Ears. Using the glue gun, apply a generous amount of glue to one side of the foam circle and stick it in the center of one side of the felt ears. Press down to avoid lumps in the glue. Once cooled, apply more glue to the top of the foam circle and fold over the felt to cover. Again, press down to avoid glue lumps. Repeat this for the second ear. After they have cooled a bit, add glue around the inside of the ears to seal them. Press together. (Make sure to leave the rectangle part of the felt open. You will glue that later.)
- Insert the headband through the opening left by the rectangles, sliding the ears into your desired position. (I kept mine 2 inches apart.) Once you have them in position, apply glue inside the opening and pinch down to secure them to the headband.
  - To create Minnie's bow, cut a 12 inch strip of the thicker ribbon. Then, cut an approximately 8 inch strip of the thinner one. Take the thicker ribbon and fold the 2 ends back until they overlap in the center. Pinch the 3 layers together.
  - Using the thinner ribbon, wrap it around the pinched area and cut. Carefully seal using the glue. Attach the bow to the headband with the thin ribbon. Cut and seal with glue. Add a spot of glue to the back of each bow to secure it to the ears.
  - Add your foam star stickers to the bow and you're ready to take the stage and sing your heart out!

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
